

Randy Beighle Board Candidate Statement – At Large (2 year)
November 2015 AGM

I am seeking a two-year At Large position. I served as Board Secretary from December 2010 until September 2014, when I was asked by the Board to step in as Board President. I was later elected Board President for a one-year term at the Club's 2014 AGM. I have decided that it is time for someone else to serve as President going forward, and I fully support Paul Dolan to be our next President. I would like to stay on the Board in an At Large position so as to help with transitions and continuity.

I have been involved in the Club for many years. I coached rec soccer for six years, both with the Club and with Issaquah Parks & Rec. I coached an ISC GU10 rec team while both my daughters were playing for ISC premier teams. I hold an E coaching license. My daughter Brecklyn presently plays on the GU15A team coached by Alex Cunliffe. I also coached my daughters in rec and select basketball.

I have been heavily involved in non-profit and public service work for 30 years. In my law practice, I have routinely provided 50-100 billable hours per year of pro bono work, and much of that work in the past 20 years has been for non-profit organizations (including ISC). In 2012, 2013 and 2014, I received *Pro Bono Publico* Service Commendations from the Washington State Bar Association.

I also served on the Washington State Bar Association's Committee of Bar Examiners for over ten years, with five of those years on the Executive Committee. The Committee of Bar Examiners is responsible for all aspects of the Washington State Bar Examination, which all attorneys must pass before they can practice law in the state.

I served on the Board of the Childrens' Museum - Seattle from 2006 to 2010, where I was on the Executive Committee of the board and held officer positions (Secretary of the Board). I left that board in December 2010 when I joined the ISC Board.
