



## *Issaquah Soccer Club (ISC) League Policy (effective 4/1/2012)*

*The purpose of this ISC policy statement is to outline the Club's league placement policies for Club teams*

**Recreational (Rec):** Covers U5 to U18 players who enjoy playing in a single fall season. Rec teams play as follows:

- U5 - U8: US Club
- U9 - U12: EYSA
- U12 - U18: WYS District II

**Arsenal (Select):** Designed to be the intermediate program between Rec and Elite, and is open to players U11 through U18. Arsenal teams:

- Will play in one league (Fall or Spring) during a seasonal year (i.e., tryouts to the following year's tryouts)
  - An Arsenal team that finishes in the top (2) of their PSPL or NPSL Fall league (especially gold or first division) will be *considered* for entry into a PSPL Spring league. Entry will be determined by the DOC prior to league play.
  - Arsenal GU-14 teams may elect to also play in Spring PSPL to allow for preparation for summer high school soccer tryouts
  - Teams may elect to play in Futsal
- High School girls teams play in Spring
  - All other Arsenal teams play in Fall
- Will play in one only of either State leagues (WSYSA/USYSA) or PSPL leagues (US Club Soccer). Exceptions must be approved by the ISC Director of Coaching.
- Will play in up to 3 summer tournaments
- Only State league teams are eligible to play in the WA State Cups

**Gunners (Elite):** Designed for players desiring a professional, year round training program currently for ages U9 through U14. Gunners teams:

- Will play in both Fall and Spring seasons



- Will play only in the PSPL
- Will play in multiple summer tournaments, which may include out of state travel
- May play in regional champions' competitions
- May play in a third Champions League
