

Adverse Weather Policy

Youth Soccer Club Weather Policy:

- Wind Policy:
 - If sustained winds reach levels where it is deemed to be placing the players in any danger, practices will be canceled for safety reasons.
 - Coaches should be vigilant for gusts or sudden changes in wind conditions that may pose a risk to players.
- Lightning Policy:
 - At the first sight of lightning or sound of thunder, all activities will be immediately suspended.
 - Practices or games will only resume 30 minutes after the last sight of lightning or sound of thunder.
 - If the lightning continues, we will send an alert to parents to come and collect their players.
- Snow Policy:
 - If there's heavy snowfall, making travel hazardous or the field unsafe, practices will be canceled.
 - When snow accumulation reaches a level that impedes safe play or movement, sessions will be called off.

Temperature Policy:

• Practice will be stopped if the temperature drops to or below 28 degrees F to ensure the safety and well-being of the players and the coaches.

For Competitive Games: It's imperative to adhere to the league rules governing weather conditions for competitive games. The safety of our players is paramount, and while competitive spirit is encouraged, the enforcement of league-mandated weather protocols will always take precedence.
